Description Map of part of the city of Hartford from just north of Albany Avenue to the north to Church Street to the south. Garden Street and several unnamed streets are to the west and Windsor Street and Village Street are to the east. An arrow at lower left points to magnetic north. Water mains run along Myrtle Street, Church Street, a portion of Windsor Street, portions of Spring Street and Spruce Street, Village Street, Morgan Street, Talcott Street, Main Street, Ann Street, High Street, Pleasant Street, Ely Street, and Walnut Street. The Almshouse, Union Depot and associated tracks and buildings, and the State Arsenal are shown. The locations of hydrants and stop cocks are indicated.
