Description Map of the province of Matanzas, Cuba, with Santa Clara to the east

Physical features include swamps and islands. Water depth in fathoms is shown

around the coastline. Other numbers are shown around on the map, in the areas

representing water. Some of the numbers have letters representing some kind of
