Description Pocket map of the United States, with part of Upper and Lower Canada to the north, the Atlantic Ocean to the east, the Gulf of Mexico to the south, and Mexico and Missouri Territory to the west. The states are colored pink, green, blue, yellow and peach. Physical features depicted included elevation, conveyed with clusters of peaks, rivers, and lakes. In the bottom left is a statistical table containing the populations of the states and their capitals in 1830. Also folded into the covers is the Traveler's Directory, which contains information about steam boat and canal routes, principal roads, and population information about the states and their towns.
