Description Pocket map of the city of Hartford, Connecticut, oriented east-west on the sheet so that the Connecticut River appears at the bottom. The streets are labeled, as are parks. The New York, New Haven and Hartford Railroad runs through town. Street railways are shown on Maple Avenue, New Britain Avenue, Broad Street, Zion Street, Wethersfield Avenue/Main Street, Windsor Avenue, Albany Avenue, Farmington Avenue, Capitol Avenue, Fairfield Avenue,

Washington Street, Blue Hills Avenue, and Asylum Avenue. On the left is a street index.
