Description Two maps within one set of covers. The main map is a pocket map of Connecticut, with the border of Massachusetts to the north, the border of Rhode Island to the east, part of Long Island and the Long Island Sound to the south, and the border of New York to the west. The state and its counties are outlined in red, with towns colored pink, yellow, blue or green. Railroad lines shown include Danbury and Norwalk; Boston, Hartford and Erie; Housatonic; Shepaug; Naugatuck; New Haven, Hartford and Springfield; Hartford,

Providence and Fishkill; New Haven and Northampton; Connecticut Valley; New York and Boston Air Line; New London Northern; and Norwich and Worcester.

Roads are also shown, and cities are depicted as small grids. Physical features include rivers and lakes/ponds.
