Description Map of New Hartford, Connecticut, with Barkhamsted to the north, Canton to the east, Harwinton and Burlington to the south, and Torrington to the west. The villages of Bakerville, Nepaug, New Hartford Center, Pine Meadow, and Town Hill are shown with their houses, businesses, and property owners.

The Farmington River and the Nepaug River are shown in blue. Elevation is indicated by hachure marks. A separate inset map at right provides detail for the

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center of New Hartford. Vignettes surrounding the map include the North

Congregational Church, the South Congregational Church, Smith and Brown's

Manufactory, the Green Woods Manufacturing Company, the New Hartford

Centre Hotel, and the residences of J. C. Smith, D. B. Smith, and Major S. Brown.
