Description Folding map of the state of Connecticut, with the Long Island Sound to the south and New York to the west. The map marks the state's major highways and uses pictures to show the locations of historic sites, including battles and notable homes and schools. Text on both sides of the image describes the significance of the pictures. On the verso are photographs and text about some of Connecticut's landmarks, a memo from the governor, and sketches of the seventeen original towns.
