The state is divided into counties, colored pink, green, yellow or blue. Main roads are depicted, as are railroads, including the New York and New Haven; Naugatuck; Housatnoic; New Haven and Northampton; Hartford and Profidence; and Willimantic to Palmer Railroads. Physical features depicted include elevation, conveyed with hachure marks; rivers; and lakes.
