Medium Papier-mâché, cotton, synthetic, paint, wood, cardboard, paper

Description Hand puppet of Red Riding Hood composed of a cloth body and a
papier-mâché head with painted features (probably using watercolor) including
red cheeks and lips, black/brown brows, and blue eyes. Her hair is made of
yellow synthetic yarn styled with bangs and two braids tied with red synthetic
ribbon. Her arms consist of cardboard tubing with hands of painted white cotton
fabric. She wears a white checked cotton blouse with white eyelet lace trim at
the neck and wrists. Her skirt, also the sleeve that conceals the puppeteer's arm
and wrist, is made of a blue and white checked cotton fabric. She also wears a
red synthetic cape with a hood. She holds a wooden basket on her left arm that
contains a folded floral-patterned paper. This puppet was possibly used with
wolf puppet (2013.182.9).
