## **Title Puppet**

Medium Papier-mâché, cotton, paint, synthetic, wool, paint, linen tape

Description Hand puppet of a duck named "Lillian Duck." It is composed of a

cloth body and a papier-mâché head painted (probably using watercolor) white

with an orange bill and gray eyes surrounded by an orange and a gray circle. The

body, two wings, and the sleeve that conceal the puppeteer's arm and wrist are

made of a gray cotton fabric. The legs and feet are made of orange wool felt. She

is wearing a pink cotton apron patterned with white dots and trimmed in light

blue. The apron is embroidered with a light blue duck on the bottom left using

cross-stitch. Tied around her head is a gray/blue synthetic kerchief.
