

Several of the photographs look down onto the traffic outside the station from an elevated viewpoint, and show passenger cars, fire trucks, a Trailways bus, police cars, and a delivery truck outside the station. In one, the fire trucks have extended a ladder to the elevated platform. Two photographs show automobiles in motion, including one taken at night. The railroad tracks appear in a couple of photos, and in one, a moving train is shown. At least two photographs were taken from Welling's apartment. One interior view shows the information desk inside Union Station with an arrivals/departures board. An exterior shot provides a closeup of the decorative wrought ironwork outisde the station. Some photographs include snow.
