Title Cheney Boathouse in Marlborough, CT

Description View of the Cheney boathouse sitting amidst trees on the edge of Marlboro Pond (Lake Terramuggus). Both doors of the boathouse sit wide open and a ramp leads down into the water. The inside of the boathouse is mostly empty, but there is a broom leaning against the right wall. At the foot of the ramp a canoe floats amidst some reeds. There are two women sitting in the canoe. The one on the left reaches down into the water with her right hand.
