Description View from above looking down. Most of the area is covered by trees, interrupted by a few scattered buildings or clearings. In the foreground there is a small railroad station building situated next to railroad tracks. The railroad station is on Elm Street, in Manchester, Connecticut, and the picture was taken from the top of the mill near by.
