Description View of a street in South Manchester during a parade celebrating the

homecoming of soldiers after World War I. Crowds of people line both sides of

the street while men in uniform march down the middle. The three story

building on the far side of the street has signs reading "C. H. TRYON", "NEW

HAVEN DAIRY / 'QUALITY ICE CREAM'", "CONNECTICUT BUSINESS COLLEGE" and

"PACKARD'S PHARMACY". The windows on the first floor are decorated with

patriotic bunting. People watch the parade from the upper windows.
