Description View of a street in South Manchester during a parade celebrating the

return of soldiers from World War I. Crowds line both sides of the street. A

marching band playing music is walking down the middle, and lines of soldiers

follow at a distance behind them. Light posts line the left side of the street, and

utility poles with posters on them line the right. In the foreground, to the right,

there is a Red Cross tent. Two nurses wearing white caps and one man stand in

front of the tent, watching the parade. There is a church steeple visible in the

distance, to the right of the road.
