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Description View of Stephen Pierson Cheney sitting on a window seat. He is

probably in the library at the Horace Bushnell Cheney house, at 78 Forest Street

in South Manchester. He is leaning back against the wall, on a pillow, and

looking out the window to his right, which is just off camera. Only the curtain is

visible. Stephen is wearing a jacket and tie, and has his hands folded in his lap.

There is a framed picture of a girl, a long slender item, and a mirror, all hanging

on the wall above his head. Another window can be seen in the background on

the left.
