

Description View of Whitneyville from the south. Industrial buildings and houses

indicated to the left and right foreground, on either side of the road. A "chesnut"

[chestnut tree is on the right and "apple trees" are in front of the large factory

building. Detailed drawings of several buildings surround the main drawing. In

1798, Eli Whitney, the inventor of the cotton gin, established the first factory in
