Description View of the central part of Clinton. A road leads down a slope and then uphill towards a Congregational Church on Meeting House Hill. At the foot of the hill the road crosses the Indian River. A shipyard, probably belonging to a member of the Buell family, with a vessel under construction is visible at the left, half-hidden behind the house. Numerous buildings are on either side of the road in the foreground, including, on the right the "Killingworth Hotel / J. C.
