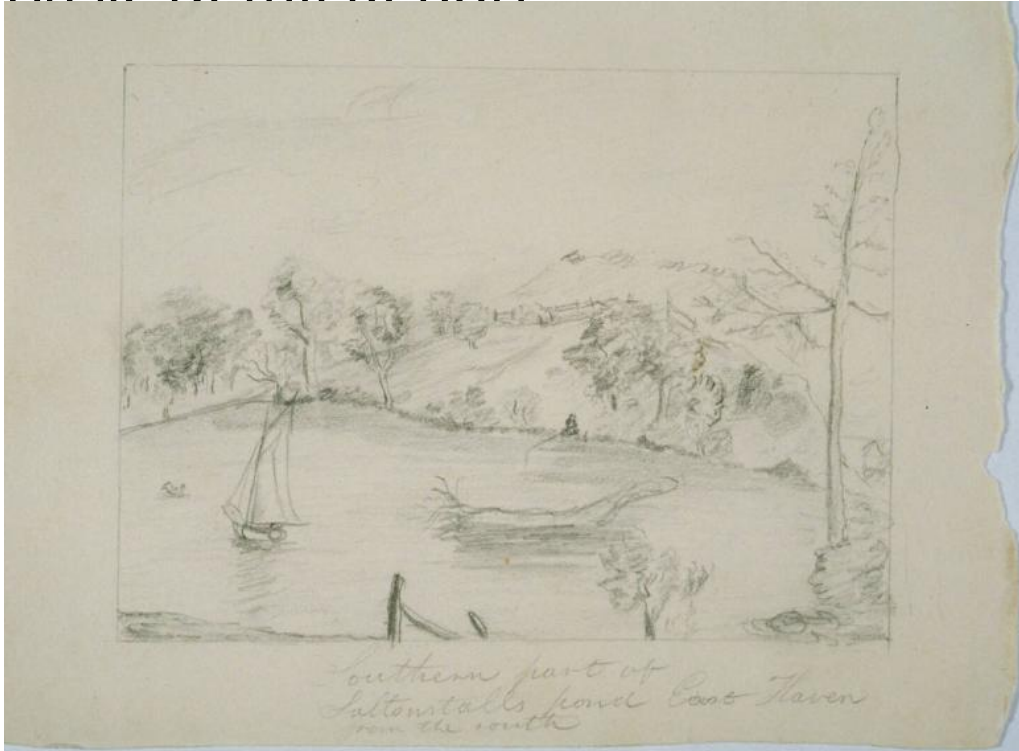


# Basic Detail Report



**Title** Southern part of Saltonstalls Pond, East Haven.

**Date** 1835

**Primary Maker** John Warner Barber

**Medium** Drawing; pencil on paper

**Description** Sailboat on a pond. Large tree at right, rail fence on hill in background. Lake Saltonstall, originally known as Furnace Pond, was named for Gordon S. Saltonstall, governor of Connecticut from 1708-17244, who is said to have owned Furnace Farm on its border

**Dimensions** Sheet (height x width): 6 11/16 x 7 7/8in. (17 x 20cm)
