**Description** View from the West side of the Connecticut River. The Connecticut River is in the immediate foreground. The strip of land beyond is Haddam Neck. Beyond Haddam Neck is Salmon Cove, a widening at the mouth of the Salmon River, which extends into the background. The tallest hill in the center is Mount Tom, in Moodus
