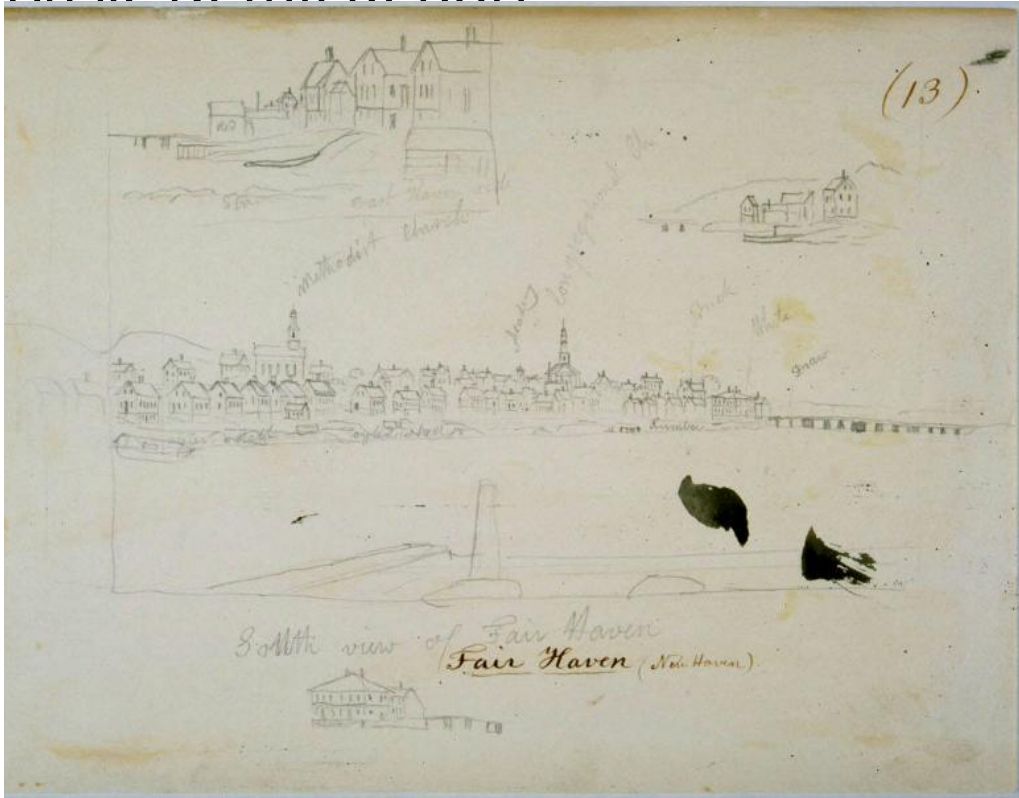


# Basic Detail Report



## Title Fair Haven (New Haven)

Description Distant view of Fair Haven from across the Quinnipiac River.

Buildings cluster thickly along the shore. Notes identify the "Methodist Church," the "Academy" and the "Congregational Ch[urch]." The shoreline is littered with piles of "oyster shells" and "Lumber." The bridge on the right is a "Draw" bridge.

Details of East Haven, (at the left end of the drawbridge) appear above the main drawing.
