**Title** North Eastern view St. Andrews Church Kent.

**Date** probably 1836

**Primary Maker** John Warner Barber

**Description** Small stone gothic church with a square tower, located at the crossroads. Barber in his text identifies it as an Episcopal Church. A picket fence is in the left foreground, a small house is across the road, and a mountain looms in the background.
