Description A view of the Ellsworth House in Windsor. The dwelling stands behind a picket fence and is surrounded by elm trees. A note on the side of the image reads "Ancient Cedar," which according to Barber's text is "about seven feet in girth, which was standing in the forest at the time Windsor was first settled, is still standing a few feet north of the house."
