**Title** North view of the borough of Clifton, in Winchester.

**Date** probably 1836

**Primary Maker** John Warner Barber

**Medium** Drawing; ink on paper

**Description** The borough is situated in a narrow valley on the banks of a millstream called Mad River (visible in the lower left of the drawing). The building with the spire in the central part of the drawing is the Methodist Church. Fencing divides the meadows in both the foreground and on the hilly background of the image.

**Dimensions** Primary Dimensions (overall height x width): 3 15/16 x 5 1/8in. (10 x 13cm)
