

# Basic Detail Report



**Title** Blacksmith class, Hillyer Institute, Y.M.C.A., Hartford, ca. 1900.

**Date** about 1900

**Primary Maker** Unknown

**Medium** Photography; gelatin silver print on paper

**Description** Young men and boys at work at anvils in what appears to be a basement classroom. Some of them hold sledge hammers, hammers or tongs. Some wear overalls or leather aprons. One man wears a bowler hat others wear caps. Several men have mustaches. A bucket and a pan of coal are in the left foreground. Large pipes extend upwards from a forge [?] and across the ceiling. Electric light bulbs hang from the ceiling on wires.
