

# Basic Detail Report



**Title** Steam ferry F.C. Fowler, Ferry Street, Hartford, 1895 or 1896

**Date** 1895-1896

**Primary Maker** Unknown

**Medium** Photography; gelatin silver print on paper

**Description** Steam ferry F.C. Fowler docked on the Hartford side of the Connecticut river. Two men and a wagon drawn by two horses are on the boat. On shore are a cart drawn by two horses, two additional men, and a woman with a basket. A small boat house has signs that read: "Boat Building" and "Boats To Let." Three people sit on the dock outside and several small rowboats are nearby. To the left is a large warehouse with a barge docked beside it. A small sailboat sails at the right. The piers of the old covered bridge are visible in the background with the spans of an iron railroad bridge beyond.
