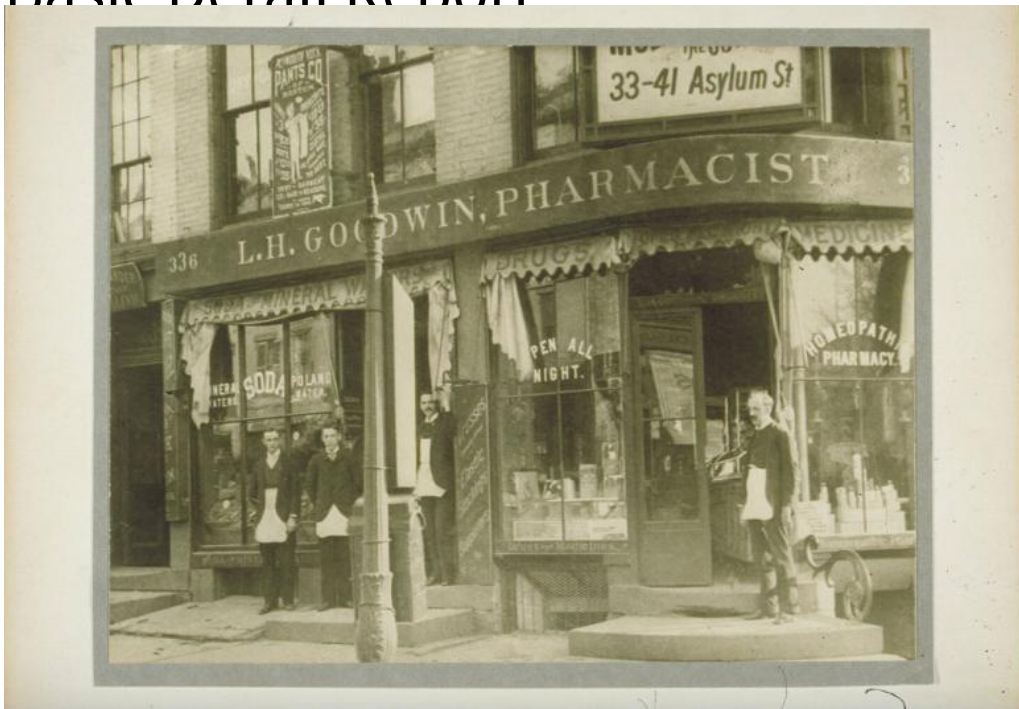


# Basic Detail Report

Elastic Stockings / Supporters" "Open All / Night" "Homeopathic / Pharmacy"

"Drugs and Medicines." Some signs are on awnings or stenciled on shop

windows. A sign on the second floor reads: "Plymouth Rock /Pants Co. / of

Boston / Overcoats / from / \$10.25 / to \$35 / Cloths... the Best / Every Garment /

Cut and Made to Measure /.. / Pants \$3 / to \$8.25 / Suits / from \$13.25 / to \$35." A

mailbox is behind an ornate pole. Three men in aprons stand nearby. A fourth

man stands at the right, near an ornate cast iron [?] bracket.
