Description Elevated view of commercial buildings along Main Street. At far left is G. Fox & Co. Beside it, the Richardsonian Romanesque brownstone building is the Cheney block, housing Brown, Thomson & Co. The next building has a clock tower. The next has a large sign on the roof that reads "Sage-Allen," followed by "Henry Kohn / & Sons / Jewelers" and a second "Sage-Allen & Co." building.
