**Title** A.E. Gunn Meat and Vegetable Market, New Haven Vicinity

**Date** about 1900

**Primary Maker** Unknown

**Description** Two-story frame commercial building with vertical board siding. A sign reads: "A.E. Gunn, / Meat and Vegetable Market." Three men and two boys stand on the porch in front of a bench.
