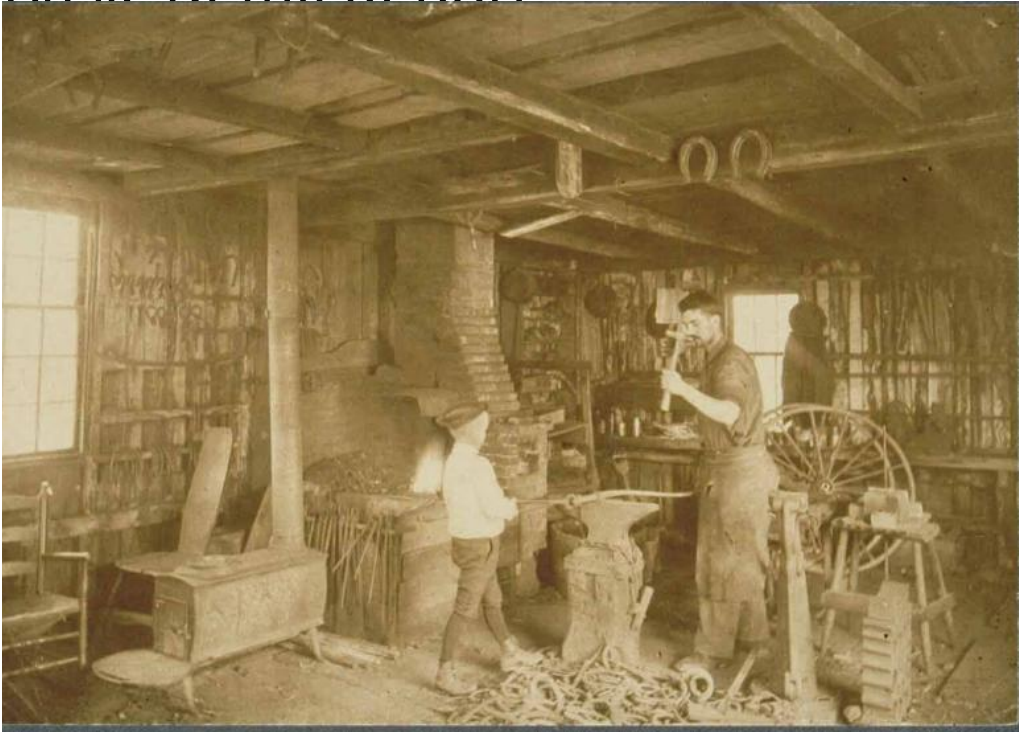


# Basic Detail Report



## Title Man and Boy in a Blacksmith Shop

Date about 1900

Description A boy wearing a cap and knickers uses tongs to hold a piece of iron on an anvil. The anvil is chained to a wooden pedestal.
