## **Title Bulkeley Bridge Celebration: Arrival of Thomas Hooker, Hartford, October 1908**

Medium Photography; gelatin silver print on paper

Description Men in seventeenth-century costume advance up a rocky slope.

Most wear tall hats and capes. One man carries a staff. One wears eyeglasses.

One has a mustache. One wears armor. Some lead cows, oxen or horses. A

woman is seated sidesaddle on one of the horses. Additional men and women

disembark from a barge on the Connecticut River. Parts of two canoes and a

man dressed as a Native American are at the far right.
