**Title Temporary Bridge Between Hartford and East Hartford,**

Description Open wooden bridge with trolley tracks, poles and wires on the right side. The bridge curves towards the north. Men in suits and hats and a small boy walk along the side of the bridge. Snow is on the bridge surface and ice is on the Connecticut River beneath. The ruins of the covered bridge are on the far right. A sign reads: "Walk / Your / Horses / Over / This Bridge." The East Hartford shore is visible in the distance.
