Title Hartford Covered Bridge with Utility Poles

Date about 1890

Primary Maker William E. Flint

Medium Photography; gelatin silver print on paper in cardboard mount

Description Covered bridge on stone abutments. A sign at the entrance reads:

"To see Bargains in Mulcahy's Window - Walk your Horses." Numerous utility poles carry wires across the river and along the street. A chicken wire fence is beside the Connecticut River. The river has ice on it. Lumber is piled beside the fence.

Dimensions Primary Dimensions (overall height x width): 5 1/8 x 8 1/4 in. (13 x 21 cm)
