## Title Display of shower-proof silk, Cheney Brothers, Manchester

Medium Photography; gelatin silver print on paper

Description Lengths of plain and patterned silk are draped in a dramatically lighted alcove. Signs read: "Shower-proof Silk" and "Printed Plush." Two potted palms are on either side. Pipes form a barrier to restrict access.
