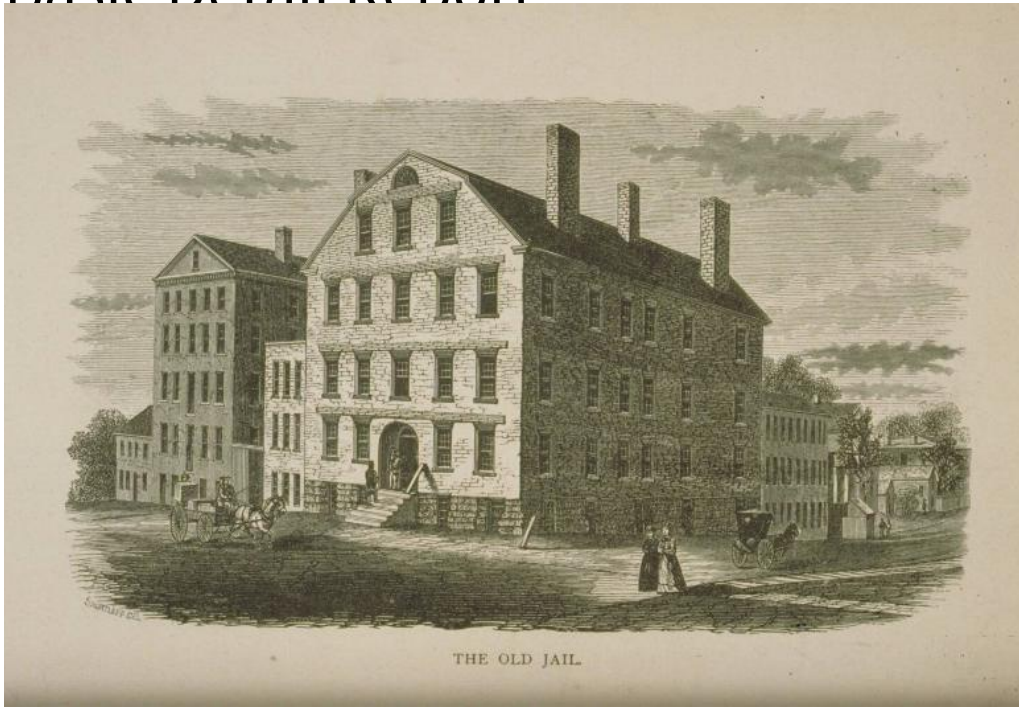


# Basic Detail Report



**Title** The Old Jail, corner of Pearl Street and Trumbull Street, Hartford

**Date** 1867-1875

**Primary Maker** Roswell Morse Shurtleff

**Medium** Wood engraving; printer's ink on wove paper

**Description** Stone or brick building with a gambrel roof and several chimneys.

Stairs lead to a round arched entrance. Men stand on the steps. Women walk in the street. A horse-drawn wagon driven by a man with a whip is at the left. A horse-drawn carriage is at the right. Other buildings, evidently commercial buildings line the streets.

**Dimensions** Primary Dimensions (overall height x width): 6 5/16 x 9 1/16in. (16 x 23cm)
