

## **Title Canteen of Myron Webster**

Date 1861-1864

Medium Steel, cotton canvas, leather, cork

Description Round metal canteen covered in a brown canvas cloth with a cork stopper in neck with a metal ring in the center which is attached to a chain which is then attached to the strap near where it passes through a "loop" on the canteen. The leather strap encircles the bottom of the canteen and the two free ends can be buckled together. Belonged to Myron Daniel Webster (1839-1864) who served with the 11th and 21st Connecticut Volunteer Infantry regiments. Dimensions Primary Dimensions (height x width):  $10 \times 8$ in.  $(25.4 \times 20.3$ cm) Component (length x width of strap):  $87 \times 1/2$ in.  $(221 \times 1.3$ cm)
