Description .2 close up view of five men, three seated and two standing, in front of a canvas tent. .3 Photograph of ten men seated along the side of a canvas tent, some in chairs and some on the ground. Other tents can be seen in the background. A camera tripod and a portion of the photographer can be seen at the far left. .4 Four beached canoes on the shore of a river with four men gathered around the third canoe from the front. Location is indicated as Point Breeze, Montville, looking west. .5 Six children playing the water in front of a sizeable hill covered in scrub. All of them are wearing hats. Identified as Point Breeze, Montville. .6 Two rowboats and a kayak in a small stream or river. A man and a woman sit on the bank atop a stone retaining wall. In the far left row boat two women are seated while a man sits on the stern. Three children are seated in the other row boat. A single woman is seated in the kayak. Identified as taken at Point Breeze, Montville. .7 A kayak with a single woman aboard, and at least one row boat making their way down a rocky stream with a stone retaining wall behind them, above which sits a brick building. A second row boat may be behind the first. There are three children, a woman and a man in the first boat. .8 A single person stands in the water up to his or her waist with both hands raised above the head. Trees are on the shore.
