Description Oval-shaped medicine bottles originally stored in an apothecary chest owned by Dr. Cyrus Pendleton of Hebron, Conn. Two bottles have a bluegreen tint and two bottles have no tint. Hand-blown glass. (.56) Embossed on front of bottle: "DR. LESURE'S/ VETERINARY/ FEVER/ DROPS/ KEENE/ NH" (.57) Embossed on front of bottle: "HUMPHREY'S/ HOMEOPATHIC/ [image of horse]/ TRADE MARK/ VETERINARY/ SPECIFICS" (.58-.59) Hammered texture on surface of glass; no identification on bottles; blue-green tint to glass Dimensions Primary Dimensions ((.56) height x diameter of base): $4\,1/4\times13$ /4in.
