Smaller forceps (.74) have a flat tip with serrated inside grip. Extraction forceps with short, blunt tip (.75) has a textured handle. Extraction forceps with long, pointed tip (.76) has

a textured handle. Container (.76) with a hinged top that opens vertically, then can move from side-to-side.
