Title Traveling Medicine Case

Primary Maker Dr. Cyrus Pendleton

Medium leather; glass; cork

Description Leather traveling medicine case originally owned by Dr. Cyrus Pendleton of Hebron, Conn. Case has a leather strap closure that wraps from the front of the case to the back. Leather is worn. Inside are twenty spaces for medicine vials. The case currently holds ten glass vials, which all have contents (powder or solid substance). Vials are not marked. Vials have cork stoppers.

Dimensions Primary Dimensions ((a) height x width x depth of case): $3 \times 5 \frac{5}{8} \times 1$ in. ($7.6 \times 14.3 \times 2.5$ cm) Primary Dimensions ((b-k) height x diameter of vials): $2 \frac{7}{8} \times 1 \frac{1}{2}$ in. (7.3×1.3 cm)
