## Title Wooden Containers

Medium wood

Description Five wooden containers of various sizes. Possibly used as pill bottles or to store medical tools, such as glass vials. Likely hand-carved. (.89a-d) Wood container with top that pulls off. Two glass vials inside, one with a cork and another without a stopper. (.90) Tall, narrow wood container with top that pulls off. No contents. (.91) Wood container with top that screws off. No contents. (.92) Small wood container with top that pulls off. Small cotton ball in top. (.93) Small wood container with top that pulls off. Small, pink, rolled paper inside container.
