# Basic Detail Report

Description Two identical commemorative medals for the veterans of World War

I. At the top of the medal is a bar with "AD LIBERTATEM" inscribed. A rainbow grosgrain ribbon is between the top bar and the medal. The medal suspended from the ribbon is round with a relief image of the Bulkeley Bridge and the Connecticut River. The medal is in its original box, made of cardboard, and is resting on a brown velvet pad.

Dimensions Primary Dimensions (length x width of medal):  $2 \frac{3}{4} \times 1 \frac{5}{8}$  in. ( $7 \times 4.1$  cm) Other (height x width x depth of box):  $\frac{5}{8} \times 2 \frac{1}{8} \times 3 \frac{1}{8}$  in. ( $1.6 \times 5.4 \times 7.9$  cm)
