## Title Navy Cross medal

Date after 1917

Primary Maker Rear Admiral Roger Welles

Medium bronze; grosgrain ribbon

Description The Navy Cross awarded to Rear Admiral Roger Welles, Jr. for his service as Director of Naval Intelligence during World War I. The medal is suspended from a blue and white striped ribbon. The front of the medal has a relief image of a ship. The reverse side of the medal has two crossed anchors and "U/ S/ N" around the anchors.
