

Description Program for Kalevala Day Celebration, February 23, 2020. The event relates to Year 21 of the Southern New England Traditional Arts Apprenticeship Program, featuring Finnish kantele playing by teaching artist Kasha Breau. Kasha played music related to the Finnish oral poetry epic the Kalevala, celebrated on February 28 in Finland. Her instrument, the kantele, is a stringed zither played by folk musicians to accompany the reciting of the Kalevala.
