Description Video of an Artists Talk at the Connecticut Office of the Arts Gallery held in conjunction with the exhibition, "Connecticut Traditional Artists and Their Communities: An Exhibit Celebrating 25 Years of CCHAP." Gideon Ampeire demonstrates and explains how to play one of the instruments he has made. Gideon invites one of the children in the audience to play the drum. The video footage was filmed by Tamara Dimitri, a Connecticut Office of the Arts staff member. The Ugandan traditional musical instruments featured in the exhibition were: - Ngoma, a drum used for music and dance, and to call people together - Enanga, a Zither used to accompany songs - Akogo, a thumb piano played by plucking the metal tines - Endigindi, a fiddle with one string, played with a bow - Adungu, a harp played as a solo instrument or in ensembles Dimensions Duration: 27 Seconds
