her right hand, she is holding a miniature that probably depicts her husband, Captain William Henry Samson. She has her left around around the shoulder of their son, William Henry Samson, Jr. He is about five years old. He is wearing a black or very dark blue jacket with a white collar and a black or dark blue bow tie. The Samsons appear to be sitting at a table covered with a patterned cloth. A book is sitting on it. In the background, there is a glass cloche on a mantel. Next to it on the left, the corner of a gilt-framed painting is just visible under a red velvet curtain.
