## HOW TO USE THE BUSES (COMO USAR LOS AUTOBUSES)

Board at front, pay fare. *Suba por el frente y pague la tarifa.*  
 Exit by rear door. *Bájese por la puerta posterior.*  
 Please request a Transfer (if needed) when you pay your fare upon boarding. Transfers are valid on ALL routes except the original route. Transfers are valid for approximately one (1) hour from the scheduled arrival time in Downtown Bridgeport. Expiration time is on Transfer. *Por favor solicite su transferencia (si es necesario) al pagar su boleto al entrar en el autobús. Los boletos de Transferencia son válidos en TODAS las rutas, excepto la ruta original. Los boletos son válidos aproximadamente una hora después de su llegada al centro de Bridgeport. La hora de expiración está en la transferencia.*  
 All GBTA vehicles are wheelchair lift equipped. Drivers will operate lift for customer. *Todos los vehículos de la GBTA están equipados con elevadores para sillas de ruedas. El conductor operará el elevador a la solicitud del cliente.*  
 On request by the elderly or disabled person, the driver will lower front area of bus for easier boarding. *A solicitud de las personas envejecidas o discapacitadas, el conductor bajará el área de subida para facilitar su entrada.*

### ELDERLY OR DISABLED SERVICES

Senior citizens and persons with physical disabilities are entitled to a reduced fare of \$.60 with approved identification. Approved identification for purposes of reduced fares are the Medicare Card and the State of Connecticut Elderly or Disabled Identification Card. To qualify for the Elderly reduced fare, a person must be 65 years of age or older. Certification by a medical doctor must be obtained to qualify for the Disabled reduced fare. Application for a State Elderly and Disabled Identification Card can be obtained from the Transit Authority.

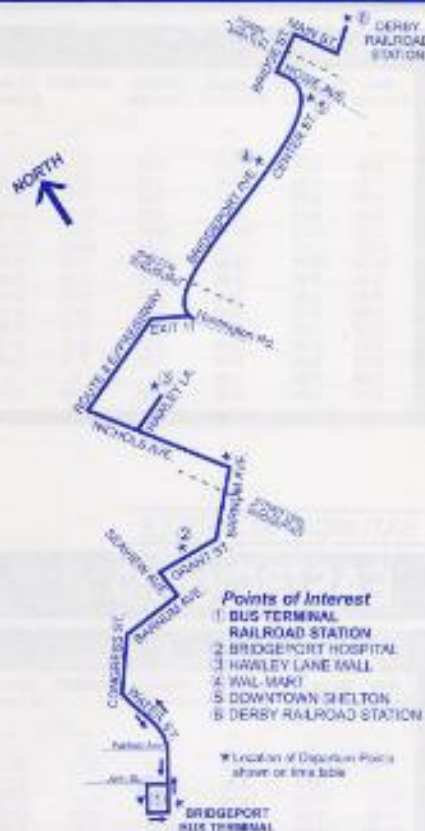

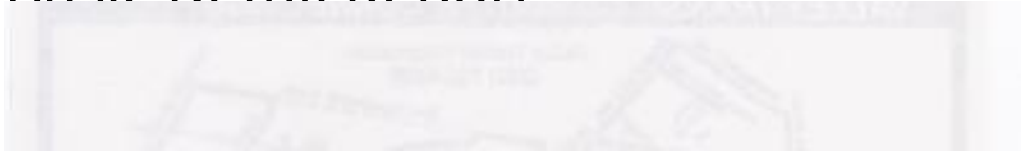
