the painting, and drapery fills the background in the upper right. Young William

is at his mother's knee, his right arm on her leg and her right hand resting on his

right shoulder. His blond hair is parted at the side. He is wearing a pale peach-

colored dress trimmed at the sleeves and neck with ruffles.
