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CONNECTICUT OPERA ROLLS BACK TICKET PRICES

Grateful to Connecticut audiences for the opera's tremendous growth in attendance over the past three years, General Director George Osborne has announced a price roll-back for the remaining two productions of the 1981-82 season--SALOME on February 24 and 27 and NABUCCO, April 1 and 3--as well as for Connecticut Opera's 1982-83 season.

Osborne said he is aware that the current economic climate has made times difficult for many people and he feels that relief can be found in the form of entertainment. Because he believes Connecticut Opera productions can provide that magical interlude for many, he does not want the price of admission to prevent any opera fans from attending the upcoming productions.

As a result of the price roll-back, opera goers will now be able to attend a Connecticut Opera production for as little as \$4. Tickets for SALOME have been reduced from \$23 to \$18, \$17.50 to \$14, \$11 to \$8, and \$7 to \$4. Tickets for NABUCCO will be reduced from \$20 to \$15, \$15 to \$12, \$11 to \$7 and \$7 to \$4.

Additional savings will be realized through April 5, 1982 by subscribers to Connecticut Opera's 1982-83 season, which will open on October 27, 28, and 29, 1982 at the Hartford Civic Center with a monumental production of TURANDOT. The season will continue at Bushnell Hall with TALES OF HOFFMANN, on December 2 and 4, 1982, LUCIA DI LAMMERMOOR, February 24 and 26, 1983 and RIGOLETTO, April 14 and 16, 1983.
