military or nobleman's costume. He is wearing a beige coat that has a tall

standing collar and gold braid on the shoulders and chest, over a white shirt and

cravat. There is a powdered wig on his head. The subject is turned slightly to the

right. The subject's eyes and lips have been hand colored. There is a blue circle

on the cravat which may be a hand-colored brooch. Horace Bushnell Cheney, Jr.

directed the Jitney Players, a traveling theater troupe. This may be a picture of

him in costume for one of their performances.
